RE: Chemical Injection Process


I am writing this letter as a personal reference to the work and chemical injection process's employed by ESSL.

As the personal owner of two large office buildings and as the Director of Development for Granite Properties I have caused the usage of the chemical injection process on a total of four large office buildings after my Geotechnical advisors, GME Consulting, indicated that the process would work best to arrest the movement of the highly plastic clay soils on the sites in question.

In both Richardson and Las Colinas the soils have a PI of over 40. All soils movement was successfully arrested and these properties have performed wonderfully to date. The Las Colinas property is over 4 years old now. The best thing about the chemical injection process besides the non-movement of the soil and the fact that I can plant landscape materials in the soil without them being killed by the old lime slurry residue is that it is far more cost effective than lime.
